TICKETS

All advance ticket sales for the 2021 AHSAA Super 7 will be available for purchase online through the AHSAA's digital ticketing partner, GoFan, by visiting https://gofan.co/AHSAA and will be \$15 plus applicable GoFan fees.

ROAD CLOSURES

- Southbound Lanes of 24th Street North between 10th Ave North and 12th Ave North
